Parents of 710 children in Walworth County received toys for Christmas. This program is set up for people in need. We receive names from food pantries, schools, Head Start, and many non-profit organizations in Walworth County dealing with families in crisis. Individuals and organizations from all around this county



From The American Red Cross regarding blood:


- Whole blood is the most flexible type of donation. It can be transfused in its original form, or used to help multiple people when separated into its specific components of red cells, plasma and platelets. All types are needed.
- Whole blood is frequently given to trauma patients and people undergoing surgery.
- The most common donation is one pint whole blood which takes about 1 hour. You can donate every 56 days, up to 6 times a year

Power Red: A Power Red donation collects the red cells but returns most of the plasma and platelets to the donor. These donors must meet specific eligibility requirements and have type A Neg, B Neg, or O blood.
